## REMEMBER, IT'S GOOD BUSINESS TO DO BUSINESS WITH A MEMBER

### Portion of Membership Dues is non-deductible

Based on federal law passed by Congress in 1993, a portion of members' dues that are attributed to lobbying is not deductible as a business expense. Therefore in 2015, the Home Builders Association of Kentucky declares that \$40 of your \$50 dues is nondeductible due to HBAK lobbying efforts.

Also the National Association of Home Builders has declared that \$27.30 of your \$182 National Dues is not deductible due to federal lobbying efforts.

Therefore \$67.30 of your total 2015 Home Builder Association dues is not deductible as a business expense.
